Supplementary Regulations

On Wednesday 24th March, Glenrothes Motor Sport Club will organise a Clubsport 12 car navigational rally starting and finishing at **Royal Tavern, corner of Main St and Strathore Rd, Thornton Fife.**

1. The event will be governed by the general regulations of the MSA Ltd. (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations, and any further written instructions of the organising club may issue for the event.

The event is open only to paid up members of Glenrothes Motor Sport Club and invited clubs

Edinburgh University Motorsports Club, 55 Car Club, 750MC(Scotland), Stonehaven and District Motor Club, Dunfermline Car Club

The Permit number for the event is 57908

2. All competitors must produce a valid club membership card at signing on. GMSC membership arrangements can be made on the night.
3. The Programme of the meeting will be
 - Scrutineering starts at 19:00 hrs.
 - Any competitor not signed on by 19:30 hrs. may be excluded.
 - Competitor Briefing will be held at 19:35 hrs.
 - First car starts at 19:46 hrs.
4. Cars will start at one minute intervals. Timing will be by marshals' watches. All times and mileages are deemed to be correct. Scheduled timing will be used throughout the event (K.17.1 and K.17.3)
5. The map required is OS Landranger 1:50,000, sheet:
 - 58 B2 (2007), "Perth & Alloa"

Any feature of the map, legend or cardboard cover may be used to define the route to be taken.

6. Entrants will be divided into classes:
 - Open - for which any crew may enter.
 - Beginner – for any crew who want simpler clues.Clues will be different for the classes, the beginner clues being designed to encourage participation – ie easy!
7. The entry list opens upon receipt of these regulations and closes at 21:00 hrs. on **Tuesday 23rd March**. The entry fee is £10.00 plus insurance. Entries can be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee, or emailed to the secretary of the meeting to be signed and paid for on the night.

Entries may be withdrawn if notified to the Secretary of the Meeting before the closing date, but may be subject to an administrative charge. To reduce costs, we would prefer to communicate by email where possible – if you have an email address, please record it on the entry form.

All officials and marshals are deemed judges of fact.
10. The maximum entry is 12 the minimum is 5. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event as necessary.
11. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
12. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with O.5
13. Competitors will be provided with time cards at the start, and route instructions as necessary throughout the event. These documents will enable competitors to comply with K.14.4.
14. Competitors will be identified by numbers that will be provided by the organisers. Numbers should be attached to the rear nearside window.
15. Marking and penalties will be as printed in K.18, with the exception of:

Failure to record a code board correctly	15 minutes
Entering a control from wrong direction	15minutes

Other typical penalties include:

Failure to visit a time control within max. lateness	30 minutes
Booking in late at a time control (per minute)	1 minute
Booking in early at a time control (per minute)	2 minutes

16. Maximum lateness on this event is 15 minutes.

17. The event will be governed by MSA regulations, with the following confirmations, modifications and specifications:

- K.16.7.1 - Route checks may take the form of code boards, a sample of which will be displayed at the start.
- K.16.1 - Controls will open 5 minutes before the due time of the first car, and close 30 minutes after the due time of last car.
- K.20.3.1 - In the event of a tie, the furthest cleanest rule will apply, failing which a timed navigational test will be used.

20. All vehicles must comply with MSA technical regulations, with the following amendments:

- E.12.19.6 - Light commercial vehicles are permitted in appropriate classes.
- K.12.11 - The carrying or use of two way radio communications equipment by competitors is strictly prohibited. Penalty for contravention - EXCLUSION.

All cars must carry a warning triangle, which will be inspected at scrutineering.

1. 21. The Lockton Motor Sports Clubs Insurance Scheme will be operated for this event. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with the third party cover necessary to meet RTA requirements. **The basic insurance premium will be £16.28.** Competitors are required to state the name of their insurers on the entry form and will additionally be required to declare in writing their insurance arrangements at signing on. Please note that there is a £250 excess on this policy, for which the competitor is liable.

Competitors wishing to use the scheme must be able to comply with all points of the Lockton Declaration:

- Over 21 years of age and held a full licence for at least 6 months.
- Not more than 1 fault accident in the last 3 years.
- No more than a maximum of 6 speeding points on licence.
- No physical or mental disabilities.
- No other material facts to disclose.

Material facts are those likely to influence the acceptance or assessment of your risk. Failure to disclose material facts may lead to the insurer declaring the resultant cover to be null and void. If you are in any doubt about facts that may be considered to be material, these should be disclosed for your own protection.

If you are unable to comply with all of the above points, you must complete a declaration form, available from the secretary, and forward it to the secretary prior to the event, allowing sufficient time for a letter of acceptance to be issued. 22. Final Instructions will be issued by email if possible and will be available on the night.

23. The correct route will be the shortest one complying with the instructions. Straight on unless otherwise instructed. No road will be used twice, with the exception of crossroads where competitors may turn left twice, but not turn right twice or go straight on twice.

24. Total mileage will be approximately 50 miles. Petrol is not available close to the start venue, but can be found at the Glenrothes.

21. Confirmation of entry will be sent to the navigator, unless a request to the contrary is made.
