

Glenrothes Motor Sport Club Ltd
2009 September Autotest
Supplementary Regulations

1 Glenrothes Motor Sport Club Ltd will promote a joint Production Clubsport status Autotest and Clubsport Autotest on Sunday September 6th 2009 at Woodside Farm by Cupar , Fife.

2.The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the RACMSA Ltd incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, these supplementary regulations, and any written instructions the promoting club may issue.

3.MSA Permit Nos. 54556 (production cars) and 54555

4.The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, 750MC, SDMC, LCC – any other club which wishes to attend should contact the event secretary. GMSA Membership costs £ 10 per adult, £12 for a couple, and £2 per junior(16 or under), and may be applied for on the day. No competition licence is required.

6.The event surface is Grass.

7.The programme of the meeting will be:-
Scrutineering starts at 10.00a.m.,
Any competitor not signed on by 10.45.a.m. may be excluded.
First car starts at 11.00.a.m.

8.The Production Autotest event will consist of classes as follows:-

- P1 Production cars up to 12ft. long.
- P2 Production cars over 12ft. up to 14ft. long.
- P3 Production cars over 14ft. Long.

The Autotest event will consist of one Open class, for any vehicle complying with MSA regulations for Autotests.

Production Car Autotest classes:-

A passenger **must be carried**. Passengers may also compete as drivers[in a separate entry].

Passengers may accompany more than one driver.

Cars must be taxed and MOT`d [if old enough] series production road going cars.

Sports cars must have a hard top or hood erected.

Drivers aged 14, 15, or 16, or drivers aged 17 who do not hold a full RTA licence, may, compete in saloon cars with 4 or more seats and with a maximum of 1400cc and without forced induction, but must be accompanied by an adult who holds a full RTA licence and is experienced in Autotesting, see MSA yearbook 9.9 and F.12.

All vehicles must comply with RACMSA Technical Regulations.

9. Child Protection - if competitor is under 18: entry form must be counter-signed by a parent or guardian; and parent or guardian or an appointed representative must be present during the competition, and must sign on the competitors signing on sheet. If a parent or guardian will not be present, a responsible adult representative must be appointed, and must show written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative, and must counter-sign the competitors signing on sheet.

10. Awards will be presented.

11. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and closes finally on Sunday 6th September 2009. The entry fee is £10 event.

13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 60 and the minimum is 3. Should any of the above figures be reached the organisers have the right to amalgamate the classes or cancel the event. Entry will be selected by receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if cancelled 24 hours prior to the event.

{b} Each driver will have 2 runs at each test with the better result to count.

(c) Timing will be by hand held watch.

(d) The starting signal will be 3,2,1,GO.

(e) The order of attempting tests will be in class order.

18. Practising will not be allowed.

19. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organisers.

20. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations.

21. All other General Regulations of the RACMSA apply as written except for the following, which are modified:-

F.4.4.3 Pylons may be less than 1 metre high.
